The Lorenzo Correa Family

This home is housing nine people. Manolo de Paula Lorenzo (47), who works in agriculture, and Toribia Corticia Correa (42) live here with their four children, Maria Esther (17), Patricia (15), Jesus Angel (13), and Rosmerlin (23) who has two young children of her own, Maria Isabela (4), and Marileini (3). Monolo's mother, Juana (70) also lives with them and suffers from dementia.







The Soto Family

Five people live in this home. Rejito Soto Abad (33), who works in agriculture, and Estefanía Jorge (25) with children Holy Wilfri (4) and Wilfreidi (2 months). Esteisi Santo (25) also lives in the home.







The Araujo Family

There are six people in the Araujo family. The father is in prison for 15 years. The mother, Teodora Araujo (35) lives in the home with their five children, Cardina Araujo (19), Eduviges Araujo (18), Amauris Araujo (16), Yefri Araujo (14), and Luis Manuel Araujo (9).
