STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Growing up, did your family have any family distinctives? What were they? What are some for your family now?

- 2. Read Colossians 1:9-14. Starting at the end, how do verses 12-14 define the Christian life? What did Christ do? What was the result for believers? What did He rescue us from and bring us to?
- 3. Give specific examples from the previous answers in your life now.
- 4. Back to the Beginning. Why do they pray for the believers in Colossae? What does it teach us about prayer in general?
- 5. Read 1:9-11 again. Name at least 5 practices that Paul specifically asks God in prayer for the Colossians. After you identify one, (i.e. like "giving thanks to the Father" in v. 12), share why you think Paul would pray that for them? Share what would it look like in your life if that "practice" were to become a daily habit?
 6. How are the practices in 9-11 the "familiy disctinctives" of the people in verses 12-14? Pray for them to manifest in believers in your life/ group by name.

AROUND THE TABLE

The Bible says that "God is Light." Why do you think it describes God in that way? Read Colossians 1:12-14. What does it mean to live in the Light rather than the domain of darkness? What did Jesus do to rescue us? *Pray: Ask God to show us how we can be a family living in the Kingdom of Light daily!*
