

STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Have you ever had to write a job description? What do you typically include or exclude? How do you decide?
2. Read Colossians 1:23-25. How are the facts that Paul is a "servant" of the gospel (v.23) and the church (v.25) connected? What is his main job to do?
3. What do you think it means that Paul's sufferings are "filling up what is lacking in Christ's afflictions" for the church?
4. Read vv. 26-27. What is the mystery that God has made known? How was it hidden in the past? How has it been revealed?
5. Read v.28-29 What is Paul's strategy to "make the word of God fully known" according to v.28? And to what end or purpose? Who does Paul mean when he says that "we" are the ones doing it?
6. Discuss the significance that Paul repeats the idea of "every one" 3 times in v. 28. Read and compare Ephesians 4:11-16 to this. Whose job is this?
7. Why does Paul describe this job as full of "suffering," "toil," and "struggle"? What makes the job harder or easier for us?

AROUND THE TABLE

Describe what a job description for parents might look like? What about for you? Read Col. 1:28. What is Paul's job in the church? Who does that in our church? In our family?
Pray: Discuss what it means to "present every one mature in Christ." Pray to do that!

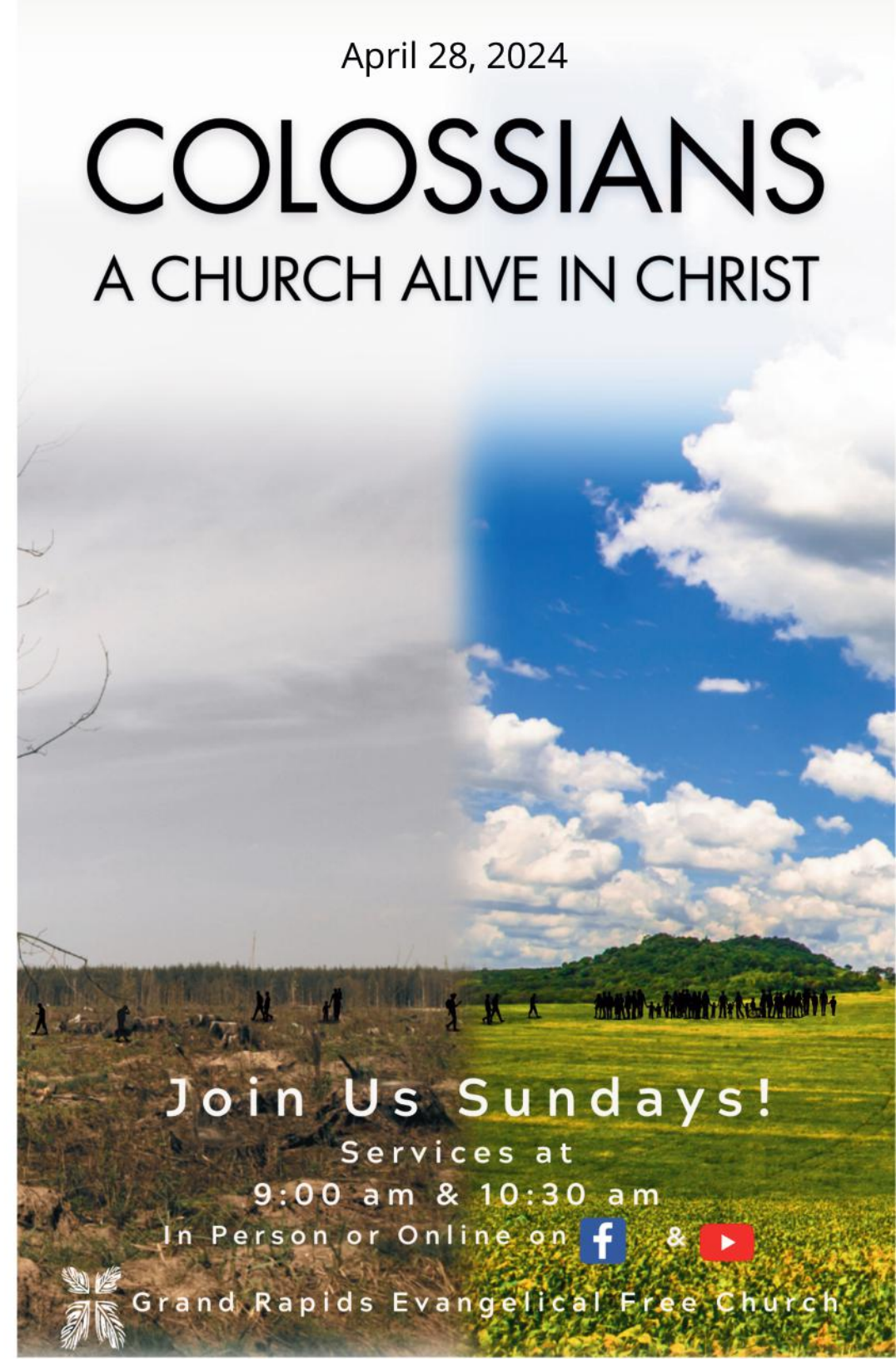
