- 5. Read 1:6-8. What two actions caused the people in Colossae to receive the Gospel? Who brought it to them and why? What does this teach us?
- 6. Read vv.4-6 again. What do these verses say about the World-wide church? What about the local church? How are they similar and different? Why is it important for believers to commit to be a part of a local church?
