STUDY QUESTIONS

Scripture: Colossians 2:6-15

- 1. Describe a major transition in your life (i.e. changing jobs, getting married, having children, graduating school, etc.). What did you have to do to "leave" your old life and embrace your "new" life?
- 2. Read Colossians 2:6-8. What ideas in these verses are commands to be done by you and which are done to you by Christ? Why is this important to know?
- 3. Read 1:19 and 2:9. What do these verses mean? And, specifically, what is the "filling" connection to 2:10?
- 4. Read 2:11-12, Galatians 6:15-16, and Romans 2:25-29 What is the difference between spiritual and physical circumcision? Why is it vital that believers are now "circumcised in Christ" instead of the flesh? How does believing in Christ make you "cut off" your old life?
- 5. Read 2:13-15. How is Christ's death and resurrection applied to the believer? How does the imagery here impact you?
- 6. How does Colossians 2:9-15 root, build up, and establish us in the faith (2:6-7)? What does it look like in your life to have these define us instead of the "philosophies and traditions" in 2:8?

AROUND THE TABLE

When we do bad things, who do we hurt? And when we sin, who do we hurt? Read Colossians 2:13-15. What did Jesus do to our sins? What does this mean for us now?
