STUDY NOTES

Scripture: Romans 1:16-2:11; Colossians 3:12-15 1. Describe a time when you called yourself

a Christian, but you didn't look very different from a non-believer. Tell us what changed.

- 2. Read Romans 1:16-17. What does it look like for the Gospel to be the "power of salvation" for believers? How does this make someone different from a non-believer?
- 3. Read Romans 1:18-2:11 What is the reason that people reject God? What things does this cause to produce in a persons life? Why, then, does 2:1 state that we have "no excuse?" How does 2:1-11 change the way we should understand 1:18-32? What's the danger of taking 1:18-32 out of context?
- 4. Given Colossians 3:5-11, how does all of this inform the way that we should see and speak to non-believers? What about believers? Should there be differences in the ways that we interact with each group? How?
- 5. Read Colossians 3:12-15. How should Christians relate with one another? What ought to define their behavior? When have you found these things easy or hard to do?

AROUND THE TABLE

Why do we change clothes every day? Read Col. 3:12-13. What do you think it looks like for a person to change their "spiritual clothes" when they become a Christian?

Pray: What things in v.12-13 do you want to see happen more in your home? Ask God to help your family live out those things daily!
