

STUDY NOTES

Scripture: Psalm 1, 2, 62, 77, 40, 136

The Lord makes it clear that His disciples *hear* His word and *do* His will (Matt 7:24), but its not always easy. What obstacles have kept you from obeying God? How can you remove them to obey God's voice now?

Read Psalm 1 and 2. How does the knowledge of God guide the Psalmist's actions and attitudes? Why can we be so tempted to only respond to God's "immediate movements," and not just simply rely on what we already know about Him?

Read Psalm 62 and 77. How do you resound with these? When God seems absent or far away, how does the Psalmist still remain faithful to God? How can we do likewise?

Read Psalm 40. What experiences cause the author to respond to God- and how does he respond? What things does the psalmist thank God for? How have you seen God move like this recently in your own life?




Read Psalm 136. Why is the repeated phrase in the Psalm so important? How do the "big reasons" shift throughout it? What does this teach us about our own responses to God?

AROUND THE TABLE

Read Psalm 117. What does it mean to praise the Lord? What reasons does the Psalm give for praising Him? How have you seen God be steadfast, loving, faithful, and enduring?

Pray: Have each person of your family pick a worship song- and sing it together. Open and close with prayer before and after this time!

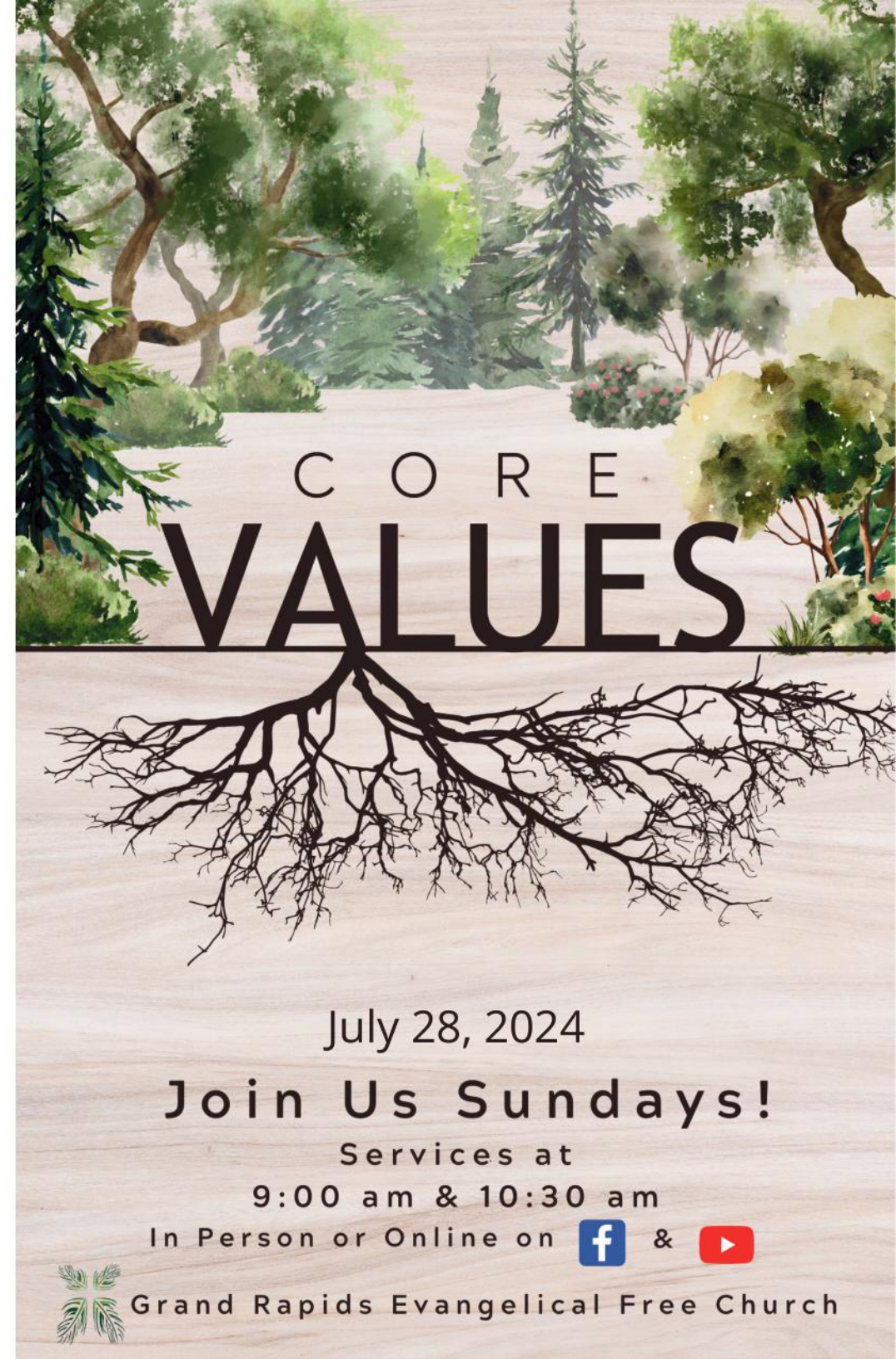
