

STUDY NOTES

Scripture: Colossians 4:7-18

What are the closest friendships you have ever experienced- and were they believers? Why or why not? Do you think it is easy or difficult to build community in the church?

Read Col. 4:7-11. Paul uses the terms "fellow" to describe many of these men- fellow slaves, prisoners, workers, etc. Why do you think this idea of "fellow-ship" is so important to Paul? How is it different then our modern idea of "Christian fellowship?"

Read Col 4:12-14 & 1:3-7. Describe Epaphras' relationship with the Colossians. Have you ever had anyone in your faith life like that? Have you ever *been* like that to someone?

Read Col 4:15-18. Why does Paul insist on the mutual "greetings" and "sharing" between these churches? How might that have continued to grow the Christian church at large- and even given us our Bibles today? In what ways might God want us to still have that kind of connection with other churches?




Why does Paul end with the 3 statements in v.18? What impact does it make? How have you been impacted by the Colossians letter?

AROUND THE TABLE

What other churches do your friends go to? Have you been to them? Have you been blessed by them? Read Col. 4:15-17. Explain why God wants believers and churches to be connected together and how we can do that!

Pray: Thank God by name for believers that have blessed you- locally and around the world!
