STUDY NOTES

Scripture: Colossians 4:7-9, Philemon 1-25 Have you ever found it easy to "be a Christian" with certain people / places but not your closest relationships? Give examples. Why do we do that?

Read Col. 4:7-9. Why did Paul send these two men? Read Philemon 1-25. What was the deeper reason that Paul sent Onesimus?

Look at Philemon 1-7 again. What kind of man was Philemon? What was his role in the church? Why was Paul encouraged? How does this intro parallel with Colossians 1?

Look at Philemon 8-16. From the text, what is the story going on here? What pieces of the story are we missing? What has happened in Onesimus' life and why is Paul getting involved? What elements from Colossians seem to be present in all this?

Look at Philemon 17-25. Why is Paul's request- and his involvement- surprising? How does Paul look like Jesus in all of this? How do Colossians 3 and 4 echo in this text?

What people speak into your life like Paul does here? Who could you ask to do it?

AROUND THE TABLE

Have you ever found it hard to forgive someone? Why? Read Col 3:12-13. What has God forgiven you for in your life? How does this give us the power & ability to forgive others?

Pray: Thank God for the things he has forgiven you for and ask for help to forgive!


