STUDY NOTES

Scripture: 1st and 2nd Corinthians What makes for a successful road trip? How do you prepare? In contrast, what can destroy a road trip? If sharing the gospel was like a road trip, what would help you succeed and what traps would you avoid?

Read Matt. 28:18-20, 1 Cor. 1:17-25, 3:1-11. How does Paul approach begin his "mission" for the Lord? What can we learn from his starting point and preparation?

Read 1 Cor. 9:16-27. What things does Paul do to intentionally share the Gospel well?

Read 1 Cor. 16:1-5, 2 Cor. 9:6-15. Why does Paul take a collection? What does the "collection" accomplish, both in the lives of the givers and in the mission of the Church?

Read 2 Cor 5:6-6:10. What surprises you in this text? How does this passage relate with the other ideas already discussed today?

Read 2 Cor. 10:13-18, 12:14-15a, 13:4-14. Why does Paul end these letters with these assertions? What does Paul explain is his ultimate purpose for all of this? Would you say this is the same purpose that you have (or should have) as well? Why or why not?

AROUND THE TABLE

What is the job of a secret agent or spy? Where do they get their missions? Read Matt 28:18-20 & 2 Cor. 5:20-6:1. Discuss what our mission is and who gives it to us. Discuss and pray about how we can pursue and accomplish that mission as a family together!
