STUDY NOTES

Scripture: Hebrews 3:7-13, 9:15-22, 1:1-4, 3:3-6, 4:11-5:5, 10:10-18, 10:19-25, 12:22-29

How do you think the ideas of rest and salvation are related? How does our society currently strive for rest? Where do they seek to find it? Why do human efforts ultimately fall short to provide true rest and salvation?

Read Hebrews 3:7-13, 9:15-22. How do the ideas of the "promised land" and being cleansed from our sins speak to humanity's greatest needs? How did even the Hebrews fail to obtain these in the Old Testament?

Hebrews is filled with comparisons about how Jesus is better. Read Hebrews 1:1-4, 3:3-6, 4:11-5:5, 10:10-18 and, after you read each section, identify what/ who is being compared with Jesus. For each example, discuss why or how humanity looks to that thing/ person to "save" them? Then discuss how Jesus is better than those false saviors.

Read Hebrews 10:19-25 and 12:22-29. How does the author depict salvation in these passages? What do the redeemed people of God gain? How is the "hope of salvation" depicted as unwavering and unshakeable?

AROUND THE TABLE

What are some things or obstacles that keep people from having a relationship with God? Read Hebrews 10:19-23. How does Jesus' death & resurrection remove those blocks? How does Jesus give us access to God?

Pray: Thank God for the ability to have a relationship with Him because of Jesus!
