

STUDY QUESTIONS

Why is it difficult sometimes who to obey- God or people? When does the line get blurred- and when does the line become clear? How can we "fear the Lord" and do His Will in all situations?

Read Exodus 1:15-21. Why did Pharaoh devise this "new plan" to deal with the Hebrews? Why would it align with the original intent in v.10?

Do you believe the Hebrew Midwives were right or wrong for disobeying Pharaoh? The text doesn't say they lied- why do many readers assume they did?

The scriptures say "The Fear of the Lord is the beginning of Wisdom." How did the Midwives' fear of God guide them rightly? How can we ensure the "Fear of God" rightly guides us today- even discerning whether situations are similar or different to what they faced?

Read Exodus 2:1-10. Why do you think God is not named in this passage? How is He nonetheless present? How can we know God is present when we are rescued in our own lives? How do these rescues foreshadow what is to come later in Exodus and in all of the Bible?

AROUND THE TABLE

How does God use believers to save and help others? Do you think He could ever use you? Read Exodus 1:15-2:10 together. How did God save the Hebrew boys? How did He save Moses? What does this tell us about God's character and how He can use faithful people?

Pray: Ask God to help your family revere, worship, and follow Him together. Ask Him to guide you all as to help others in His name.
