

STUDY NOTES

How do some of your values (religion, faith, education, politics, family, etc.) play out in your day-to-day life? How might your values shape a “mission statement” for your life?

Read Philippians 3:7-10 and Ephesians 3:7-10. According to these texts, why might Paul describe his ultimate mission as “knowing Christ?” What in these passages could lead us to that understanding?

What things in your life could be obstacles (or rubbish or refuse) compared to knowing Christ Jesus? How might the Lord be calling you to surrender those things to know Him more?

Read Ephesians 3:14-20, 4:11-16 and Philippians 1:6-11, 15-18. According to these passages, how are we called to know Christ together, not just as individuals? How does the Church aid in us knowing Christ?

Read Ephesians 4:25-5:2 and Philippians 2:1-18. How do these passages paint the picture of the Church “making Christ known together?” In what ways can we do this together as a Church?

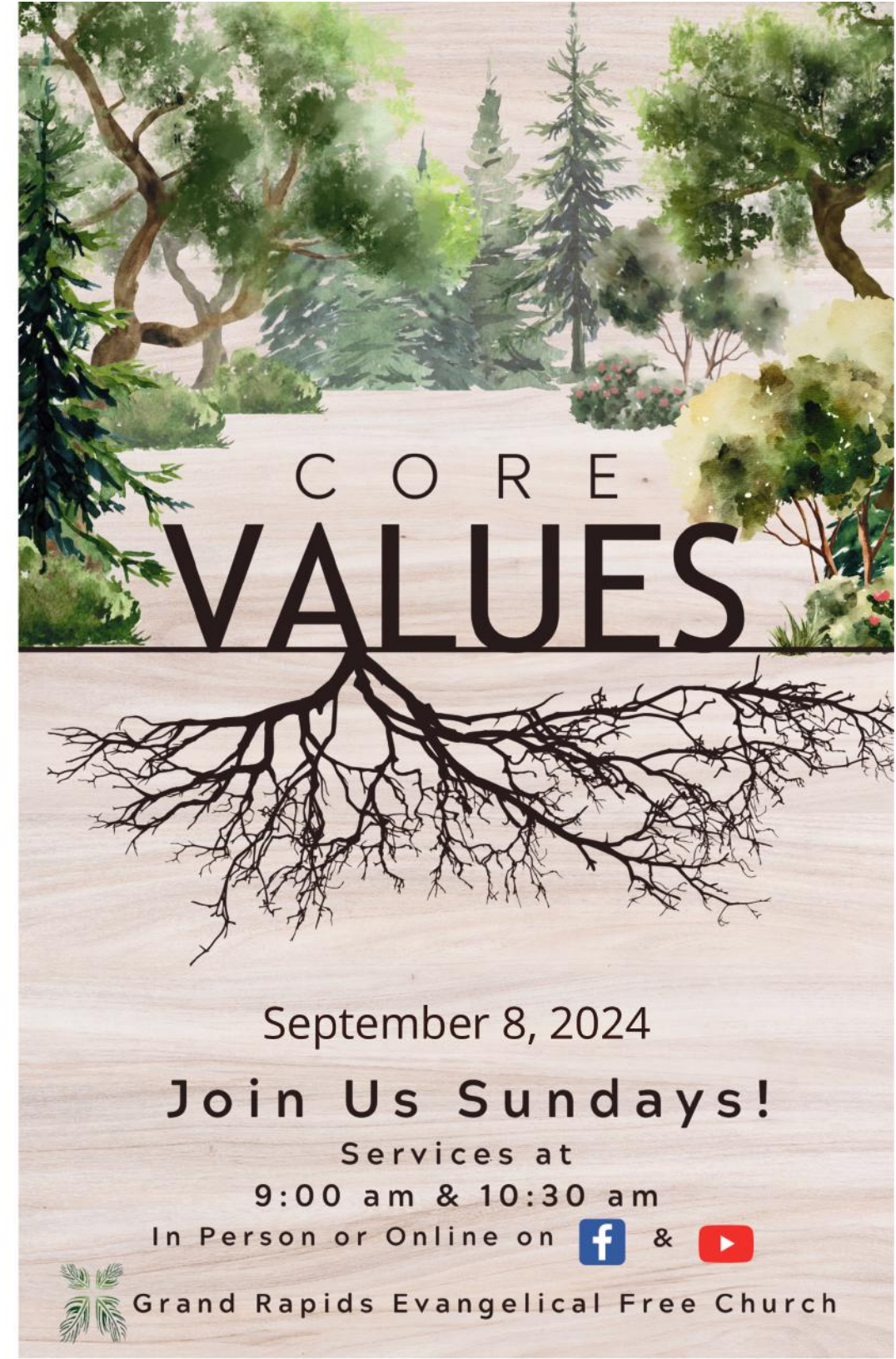

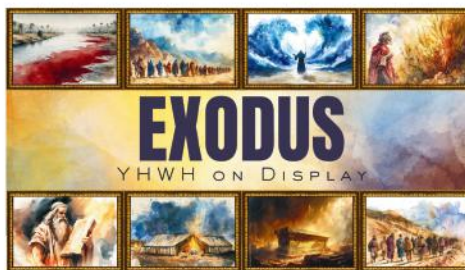
