

STUDY QUESTIONS

Tell of a time you tried to do the right thing, but in the wrong way- especially in terms of living for God? How did it end up? What did you learn through it?

Read Exodus 2:11-15. Name the ways that it seems Moses is identifying "as a Hebrew." Why is this important? Do his Hebrew kinsmen accept or reject him? Where did Moses seem to go wrong?

Read Exodus 2:16-22. What happens to Moses in Midian? How does it seem that his attitude in life has changed? How does God use this journey to shape Moses' heart and character?

Read Exodus 2:23-25. What 4 verbs are directly connected with God and the suffering of His people? What can we learn about God's response to our suffering? What was the greater story happening unknown to the Hebrews?

AROUND THE TABLE

What do you think it means when we call to God for help- and it feels like He isn't answering? Read Ex. 2:23-25. Why were the Israelites suffering? Do you think that God had abandoned them?

Pray: Name some hard things you are facing as a family. Ask God to help you.
