

STUDY QUESTIONS

Would you describe yourself as obstinate or open minded? How so? How can obstinance towards God become a dangerous thing? How could "openness" also go too far?

Read Exodus 7:14-25. Why did God's first "wonder" turn the Nile to blood? What did this demonstrate? What was His purpose? And did Pharoah get what God was trying to do here?

Read Exodus 8:1-15. Why would God use the Nile now for a second time? And why the influx of frogs? Pharaoh ask for Moses to have them removed "tomorrow." What does this delay and Pharaoh's false promise show about Pharaoh's will and character?

Read Ex. 8:16-19. What does the Magicians' response demonstrate? What about Pharaoh's fixed refusal?

AROUND THE TABLE

Have you ever refused to listen to good advice? What about if things went bad after- did you still refuse? Read Ex 7:14-8:19. Why did God send plagues against Pharaoh and Egypt? What plagues did He first send? And did Pharaoh listen? Why or why not?

PRAY: Talk about ways that God has tried to get you to listen. Ask God to help you clearly hear & follow Him.
