

STUDY QUESTIONS

Do you agree or disagree with the statement, "The Chief End of Man is to Glorify God and Enjoy Him Forever"? Is there a danger in only holding to one part of it, rather than both together?

Read Exodus 9:13-35. How do you see God's glory & sovereignty in this text? What about His love, grace, & mercy? In the text, what different responses towards God do you see from people?

Read Exodus 10:1-20. What purpose does God give Moses for hardening Pharaoh's heart in v.1-2? How and why does this plague break the "pattern" found in the earlier plague accounts?

Read Exodus 10:21-29. What about this plague hits upon some greater biblical themes? How does this plague point to the need for Jesus Christ? How does Pharaoh's response condemn himself?

AROUND THE TABLE

What do you think it means to enjoy God? What about to glorify God? What about to love God? Are they different? Read Ex. 9:13-10:29. Now read 10:1-2 again. How does this passage imply that we would talk about God, His actions, and our responses as a family?

PRAY: Share ways that God has shown you who He is from the Bible and your own life. Thank Him for those things!
