

# STUDY QUESTIONS

What is the greatest glory you have experienced (i.e. a sports victory, a play performance, a concert, winning an election)? How did it feel? How were you shown glory? How'd you respond?

Read Ex. 14:1-14 What observation tempted Pharaoh's stubborn will? What about his servants? How would God use their sinful wills against them?

Can you empathize with Israel's cries against Moses in v.11? What about his response? How are the words in v.14 meant both as a comfort & correction?



Read Ex. 14:15-25. Why does God emphasize getting "glory over Pharaoh" so "the Egyptians would know Him"? What were the multiple purposes for the Red Sea miracle?

Read Ex. 14:26-31. How did Israel respond to the Red Sea miracle? How do you respond as you reflect on this?

## AROUND THE TABLE

Have you ever won a game or had a big concert/ performance? How did you feel afterwards? Read Ex. 14:1-31. How did God defeat Pharaoh and his army? How did He rescue Israel? How was He glorified in victory by Israel & Egypt?  
**Discuss and pray about ways that your family can give God glory more & why!**
