

STUDY QUESTIONS

Have you seen or been a part of a legal contract? What elements or witnesses were present? Was there a ceremony? What did the proceedings say?

Read Exodus 19:1-8. How is this chapter a climax point in the book? What happens here that is so critical? How should we understand God's promises for Israel as believers today?

Read Exodus 19:9-20. What do the people need to consecrate themselves? Close your eyes and imagine the scene. Why was God's presence so terrifying?

Read Exodus 19:21-25. What is unique about the limits God sets for His people here? Why does He do it? What do these tell us about God, mankind, and our relationship with Him? Read Heb12. How does this affect your understanding of this as a Christian?

AROUND THE TABLE

Have you ever made "a deal" with someone? What was the outline of the deal? Read Ex. 19:1-25. What is the "deal" God makes with Israel? How do they respond? What does this scene tell us about God? How should this affect the way that we worship God? **Discuss and pray about how your family can believe God's promises and worship Him with reverence.**
