

# STUDY QUESTIONS

Do you think the “separation of church & state” really exists? Do you think God ultimately desires them to be separate?

Read 1 Chron. 15:25-16:7. What stands out to you as “strange” in this account? Do you think David crosses lines here, especially in regards to the priesthood?

Read Luke 19:28-40. Compare 1 Chron. 15:25-16:7. What is similar or different? How does Jesus’ triumphant entry seem to “fulfill” the parade in 1 Chron. 15-16?

Read 2 Chron. 26:3-5, 15-23. What does Uzziah do right, at first? Where does he go wrong? What leads him to this error?

Read Luke 19:41-48. How does Jesus act like a priest (instead of a king) in this passage? Why can He cross the line that Uzziah couldn’t? How does Heb 4:14-5:6 explain Jesus is our High Priest & King?

## AROUND THE TABLE

Read 1 Chron. 15:25-16:7 and point out the ways that King David acts like a priest. Now read 2 Chron. 26:3-5, 15-23 and discuss what happens when King Uzziah tries to act like both. Finally read Luke 19:28-48 and discuss why it’s important to see Jesus as Priest & King. **Pray and thank Jesus for being both our Savior (Priest) and Lord (King).**
