

STUDY QUESTIONS

What are things that our society idolizes? Do you think that these are in alignment with God's heart or against it? How should we respond to idols in the world?

Read Exodus 32:1-6. What reasons are given for the Israelite's sinful rebellion? Do you think it was intentional or not?

Read Exodus 32:7-20. How does God respond to their sin? Why does His response change? How does Moses' response change as well? How do they both reflect a tension in justice & mercy?

Read Exodus 32:21-29. What does this teach us about our tendency to avoid sin and confession? What does this also demonstrate about Godly accountability?

Read Exodus 32:30-33:6 How does Moses appeal to God? How does He respond? Why are there consequences? How do the people respond to God now?

AROUND THE TABLE

Is it wrong to disobey God? How do you think God responds to our sin?

Read Exodus 32:1-14. Why do the people sin? How does God react? What about Moses? What can we learn about our sins and God's heart?

Confess ways you disobey God & pray for forgiveness together. Commit and discuss how to follow Him again!
